Rules for Canned Goods

1. All canned products must be processed according to USDA recommendations.
2. Regulation jars with two-piece lids and rings. Both lid pieces must be on jar. Rusty rings and lids disqualify exhibit.
3. Jams, jellies and preserves must be in a regulation jar, sealed with a two-piece lid. Paraffin sealed jars will not be judged.
4. Jars may be opened by request of the judge.
5. All entries must be labeled.

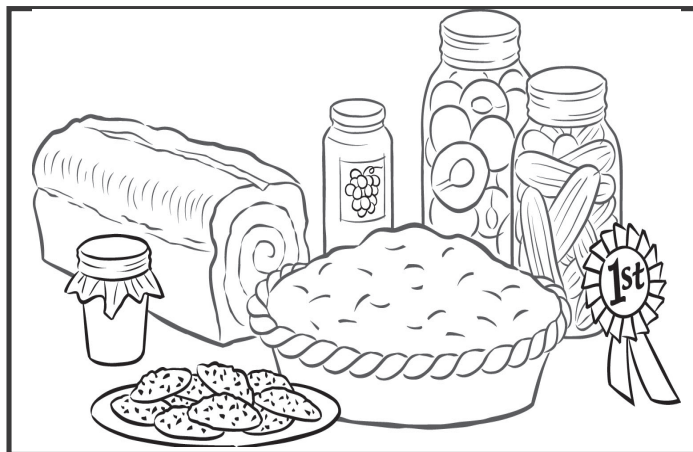

RULES FOR BAKED FOODS

1. Bring whole cake, pie or loaf of bread for judging.
2. Please note in class descriptions amount of other food products to display.
3. All recipes should be made from scratch unless specified otherwise.
4. Bread machine bread shall not be made from mixes; must be scratch.
5. Pies must be in aluminum pie tin, covered with plastic wrap or in a plastic bag.
6. Products other than pies must be on a disposable plate and covered with plastic or in a plastic bag.
7. Candies should have three pieces on a disposable plate in a plastic bag or covered with plastic wrap.
8. Cookies should be on a disposable dessert plate in a plastic bag or covered with plastic wrap. Three cookies per exhibit.
9. Limit two entries per class. Double entries should not be from the same recipe.
